Use of Hoses	All hoses must be fitted with an on/off nozzle
Swimming Pool – Private	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Filling of new pools allowed</li> <li>• Topping up of pools allowed</li> <li>• Emptying and refilling of existing pools banned</li> </ul>
Washing of driveways, paved areas and roofs	Buckets or watering cans only for health and safety reasons

Swimming Pool – Private	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Filling of new pools allowed</li> <li>• Topping up of pools allowed</li> <li>• Emptying and refilling of existing pools banned</li> </ul>
Washing of driveways, paved areas and roofs	Buckets or watering cans only for health and safety reasons

Use of Hoses	All hoses must be fitted with an on/off nozzle
Swimming Pool – Private	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Filling of new pools allowed</li> <li>• Topping up of pools allowed</li> <li>• Emptying and refilling of existing pools banned</li> </ul>
Washing of driveways, paved areas and roofs	Buckets or watering cans only for health and safety reasons

## Water Restrictions Level 4

### DOMESTIC

Gardens, Car Washing, Window Cleaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sprinklers and fixed hoses banned</li> <li>• Hand held hoses can be used for 1 hour per day between the hours of 7.00pm-8.00pm odds and evens system</li> <li>• Buckets and watering cans are permitted for use in gardens</li> </ul>
Use of Hoses	All hoses must be fitted with an on/off nozzle
Swimming Pool – Private	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Topping up of pools to the skimmer box allowed by hand held hose only to prevent structural damage ½ hour per week on Mondays 5.30pm-6pm</li> <li>• Emptying and refilling of existing pools banned</li> <li>• New pools to be filled only to the skimmer box to prevent structural damage</li> </ul>
Washing of driveways, paved areas and roofs	Buckets or watering cans only

Public Gardens and general paved areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sprinklers and fixed hoses banned</li> <li>• Hand held hoses can be used for ½ hour per day between the hours of 7.30pm-8pm</li> </ul>
Sports Grounds (General)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sprinklers and fixed hoses banned</li> <li>• Hand held hoses can be used for ½ hour per day between the hours of 7.30pm-8pm</li> </ul>
Sports Grounds (Turf cricket pitches only)	Hand held hoses for 1 hour per day 7am-8am
Nurseries & Commercial Flower Gardens	Sprinklers/hand watering 1 hour per day 7am-8am. Watering cans or buckets allowed at all times
Washing Motor Vehicles & Car detailing business	Buckets or Machine Recirculation only
Washing of Buses, taxis, Food Transport, Ambulances & Garbage Vehicles	Buckets or Machine Recirculation only
Building	Limited to essential business use only
Paved public areas, where food is prepared or consumed, or for health reasons	Bucket or mop watering can only

Car washing	Town water banned

Swimming Pool – Private	Town water topping up and filling banned
